The Major Agricultural Scientific Hands-On Educational Event in Ukraine in 2024

Join us from June 26 to July 11, 2024, for an enriching agricultural journey through Ukraine, merging hands-on scientific engagement with the exploration of Ukraine's rich cultural heritage. This tour offers a balanced 50/50 mix of agricultural education and sightseeing, designed to immerse participants in the latest achievements in soil fertility, microbiology, entomology, and disease control, all while exploring the scenic beauty and resilience of Ukraine.

The crops you will see – soybean, corn, wheat, barley, sunflower, canola, and other niche crops within the crop rotation system, like alfalfa, buckwheat, millet, ryegrass, flex, etc. You will have a chance to see farms and operations of difference scale, from private farmers and small family farms to agricultural holdings.

The field and farm visits are naturally combined with an extensive rural sightseeing program at the rate of 50 by 50.

Itinerary

Europe – Ukraine (Volyn (Lutsk, Rivne) – Lviv – Ternopil – Zhytomyr – Kyiv – Cherkasy – Kropyvnytskyi – Vinnysya).

Field Agricultural Council Tour is scheduled to take place from June 26 to July 11, a part of the World to Rebuild Rural Ukraine charitable initiative. The tour program offers a unique opportunity to join 10 highly reputable world consultants on soil fertility from the United States and Germany hosted by seven Ukrainian farms located in different regions of Ukraine. These regions were chosen to reflect the diversity of Ukrainian soils and climatic conditions. The annual precipitation rate in the selected regions varies from 400 to 750 mm. The field visits will result in a three day on-the-farm Conference hosting farmers and agribusiness experts from all over Ukraine as well as foreigners.





If you get overwhelmed by a number of field trips, roots and field scouting, take a chance to enjoy the cultural heritage of Ukraine, as each day of the tour offers an alternative route to relax and explore Ukraine. The cultural program uncovers Ukraine through the lens of its agricultural prowess and cultural heritage. It offers visits to farms, and factories producing the most modern equipment, visits to the newest Ukrainian mills, as well as sightseeing spots along the tour route. You will have the ability to immerse in the life of Ukrainians by visiting areas recently liberated from occupation.

Witness firsthand the resilience and beauty of Ukraine's rural and urban life.

Safety

Your safety is our paramount concern. TraveliteAGRO team sees the war risks during the tour as minimal – such as do not accede risks when driving a highway. Despite central Ukraine being relatively safe, we are taking extensive security precautions. The tour, is overseen by the Ministry of Agricultural Affairs of Ukraine, has been meticulously planned to avoid any potential risks. We have obtained approvals from military administrations for all tour locations. The names of the farms as well as the exact route of our group will NOT be published openly until the day of the visits.

However, everyone should be aware of the fact that russian aggression has not been stopped and air-raid alerts and shelling are real. All the farms, facilities, tourist places and hotels within our itinerary are equipped with shelters. The group will be accompanied by at least 5 of TraveliteAGRO coordinators.





Insurance

We have arranged comprehensive medical insurance for all our international guests, covering ALL potential health-related incidents. This includes access to both Ukrainian private and European hospitals, with our TraveliteAGRO team available to ensure prompt transportation to recommended clinics.

The Conference

Scheduled for July 8-10, the conference will be a pivotal moment for sharing observations and recommendations based on the farm visits. This will also serve as an invaluable networking opportunity, expected to attract over a hundred participants in person.

Tour Itinerary

The tour includes visits to six farms, with a concluding conference held at a seventh farm in Vinnytsia oblast. Activities will involve thorough inspections and analyses of agricultural practices, conducted with your comfort in mind under movable sunshades with seating provided. The insights gathered will be compiled into comprehensive reports for each host farm.

 - Visit Lubart's Castle, the symbol of Lutsk and the main city attraction. Emerge into the medieval atmosphere of the old town.
- Upon request: Visit Lutsk underground complex topped the five most mysterious undergrounds of Ukraine. A church, a refectory, tombs, a prison, and numerous secret passages were located underground.

- Visit July Morning Observatory, the only private astronomical observatory in Ukraine. The observatory observes the rings of Saturn, the satellites of Jupiter, the sickle of Venus, and also works on the creation of a telescope capable of seeing objects a million times weaker than those seen by human vision.

- Drive to Kyiv. Check into a hotel.
- Dinner.

Day 6 1.07 (Mon)

- Day off.
 - **Explore Kyiv.** Walk along Khreschatyk Street, St. Sophia Cathedral, etc. Visit a current exhibition at the Ukrainian House.
 - Lunch at «Sto Rokiv Tomu Vpered», a modern Ukrainian restaurant exploring national gastronotic traditions.
 - **Drive to Dobra Ferma** visit a small family farm producing goat cheese. Farm tour and cheese tasting.
 - Visit a small farmer who grows vegetables known as «borsch set». Meet farm manager, discuss his production goals and problems he faces during war time.

- Visit a private plant which develops and produces highly efficient fertilizers. They provide customers with full advisory support in the field of plant nutrition, share the experience of optimizing production costs to increase the profitability of the crop industry.


